GUIDELINES FOR SEQUENCES

- 1) Open to all members
- 2) This is not a competition, but simply another format for members to show their work
- 3) Members may submit any number of sequences
- 4) There is no restriction on subject matter, but sequences are generally more successful if they have a theme
- 5) Sequences may be a joint effort, but the production must be the original work of the entrant and his/her declared co-authors
- 6) Entries must be submitted to Chris Wallace at least one week prior to evening.
- 7) Sequences should be on CD-ROM or DVD. These will be returned after the event. Please ensure your name is on the CD/DVD
- 8) For ease of viewing on the night, all entries will be copied onto the laptop hard drive
- 9) Sequences should preferably be submitted as an EXECUTABLE file (i.e. one that will auto-run in Windows). These normally have a .exe file extension
- 10) Alternatively they may run in the following application software:
 - Pictures to Exe (PTE)
 - PowerPoint
 - Elements 4
- 11) The duration of the sequence should ideally be between 2 and 5 mins but no longer than a maximum of 7 mins
- 12) Image dimensions should not exceed 1024 pixels wide by 768 pixels tall
- 13) The accompanying audio track may be either vocal commentary or music (or both if you're feeling really adventurous!)
